	On 04 April 2013, a plastic factory godown caught fire in the City Market area. Civil Defence volunteers helped the Fire Brigade in putting out the fire and carrying out rescue operations.	
<b>Maharashtra</b>	A fire occurred at 4th floor Sushrut Hospital< Mumbai on 04 April 2013. The Civil Defence QRT team comprising of 7 CD volunteers helped the fire brigade in the rescue operations.	
	A seven-storey building collapsed into a mangled heap of steel and concrete more than 20 feet high that rescuers and local residents struggled to cut through on	

Thursday evening at 06.30 pm. 38 people, including 11 children, were crushed to death in Thane on the outskirts of Mumbai in the building that was under-construction. Around 50 people have been rescued by Local & Civil Defence volunteers, but some are still believed trapped in the debris. Dy.Controller of Civil Defence Maj (Retd.) Laxmikant Davare responded immediately to the incident with his staff & volunteers and with assistance to the local Fire & Emergency Services rescued many people in the golden hour period.....
